FRESH PERSPECTIVE During Contemporary Arts Museum

Houston's (camh.org) 70th anniversary celebrations, the institution launched the New Perspectives Capital Campaign—its first in 20 years. As of November, CAMH had not only secured 81% of its \$3.1 million goal, but it had also completed the first phase of the project: relocating the administrative offices to an off-site space. Other planned facility improvements, which are expected by summer 2020, include expanding the public gathering space, improving visibility by updating external lighting, clarifying exterior signage and more. Led by a small steering committee, which is co-chaired by Jereann Chaney and Dillon A. Kyle, the project will help CAMH accommodate its growing level of attendance in alignment with its pioneering spirit and mission of presenting thought-provoking programming and exhibitions that showcase works by artists of different cultures and backgrounds. —LEK
